We pursue integrated teaching models through peer interactions among children and between children and teachers in a happy, positive, creative learning environment. This is a great way to stimulate children's active learning, and through outdoor learning experience, children can put into practice in their daily lives what they learn at school.

Curriculum Details

We will follow the "Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide" (2017) to plan curriculum. Children of nursery classes will not be asked to write, and there will not be mechanical copying exercises and drills on calculation.

Learning / Teaching approach & activities

1. We guide children to actively explore problems by storytelling, and children learn knowledge and exploit their potential during observation, discussion and practice. We also use various elements such as Chinese and English, general knowledge, numeracy and visual arts, to achieve children's balanced development in all aspects. 2. We engage native teachers and professional Mandarin teachers, and children are exposed to different languages during playing games. 3. We encourage children to actively involve themselves in social services and learn to share with others, thus fostering their sentiments of loving their lives and families, and caring for social concerns. Activities: interest activities, living and routine training, physical training, music, snacks tasting, natural science, drawing, etc.; interest classes, regular outdoor visits and explorations, parent-child activities and parents.
